ARTISTS' REGISTRATION-New & Returning

Welcome to all new and returning artists! You can register, pay and upload your TWO images for jurying at the website below. You may register as a 2D artist and/or a 3D artist, online or at the Arboretum office. The costs are as follows:

- Non-WAA Members \$35 for each category • WAA Members \$25 for each category (*membership will be verified*)

Once you have uploaded your two images for jurying at the website above, the images will be juried by the Art Committee. You will be notified if you have been accepted into the Art Show and Sale and you will then receive the next steps.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

ART WORK SPECS:

- 2D includes paintings, photography, drawings, textiles, banners- all gallery-hung pieces must be originals, no giclee, prints or reproductions
- 3D includes ceramics, sculpture, glass, metal, wood, stone, textiles, jewelry
- All art will be juried and must not have been submitted or shown in this Show within the past 4 years
- The Art Committee reserves the right to remove or reject art from the Show that is deemed inappropriate
- 2D - 20 pound wt. limit per piece; max of 48" height or width on unframed piece
- 1 1/2" gallery wrap pieces must have finished edges or be framed
- 3/4" gallery wrap pieces must be framed

YOUR PRESENCE AT THE SHOW:

- Outdoor 3D artists will set up their own installation with guidance from the Art Committee
- All tabled (small item) 3-D artists will be required to staff their tables during the entire Show, either personally or by a representative. If by representative please provide the Art Committee the name of the person assisting
- 3D artists-Conflicts with the Friday schedule can be discussed with the Art Committee
- Garden (large item) 3D artists' presence at the Show is optional
- 3D artists not working during the Show and 2D artists are requested and encouraged to volunteer for at least one 3-hour shift to help with the Show. We simply could not have this event without the generous offer of your volunteer time.

SALES INFORMATION:

- Artists will receive 70% of proceeds from the sale of their art; Friends of the Arboretum will retain a commission of 30% on all art sold during the Show
- All sales will be handled through the Friends of the Arboretum; no independent sales allowed during the Show
- NC sales tax will be collected and remitted by the Friends of the Arboretum
